How to Enter

\$10 per entry; multiple entries OK; Maui County residents only. Bring artwork framed and ready to hang and fill out entry forms at Viewpoints Gallery on receiving day. Be prepared to set a retail price - all artwork (except keiki) must be for sale. EMWP reserves the right to use images of selected artwork for outreach purposes.

Juror's Choices: 2-Dimension, 3-Dimension, & Photography

Rarest Find: most unique native species or native habitat

People's Choice: most votes from gallery visitors

Art of Conservation: best captures the essence, theme or message of conservation

* one award chosen from the entire exhibition - both keiki and adult divisions
